Be patient and kind

Exercise Christian charity as we all learn to adapt to a new reality.


Arrive no more than 30 minutes before Mass and no less than 10 minutes before Mass and cooperate with instructions upon arrival.



Before Mass...

Practice Social Distancing

Maintain six feet distance from others who are not members of your household.



During Mass...

Minimize touching

Don't hold hands for Our Father, offer a simple nod or wave for the Sign of Peace, and use foot to adjust kneeler.



Wear a face mask

Masks must be worn at all times on parish grounds and in church, except for reception of Holy Communion.


Masks must cover nose and mouth.



Follow instructions for reception of Holy Communion

Ministers of communion will sanitize hands and wear masks.

- Ministers of Welcome will invite you to sanitize your hands as you enter communion line.
- Follow markings on floor to maintain social distance.
- Receive host in hand, step to the side, remove mask from one side to consume, then re-apply mask.



Sanitize hands

A Minister of Welcome will offer you hand sanitizer as you are welcomed into the church.



You may wish to bring your own hand sanitizer as well.

After Mass...

Remain until dismissed

A Minister of Welcome will escort you from your pew in a manner that respects social distance.



Disperse after dismissal

The church and narthex must be vacated immediately after Mass so we can sanitize for the next Mass.
